Sunstory Limited was founded in 2005 by Dimitre Georgiev as a Bulgarian private limited company focusing on services in the tourism and hospitality sector, including holiday property investment, development and management.

Prior to his involvement with Sunstory, Mr Georgiev has owned and managed consultancy businesses in London, UK since 1995 in the sectors of information technology, accountancy & taxation and overseas real estate.

Svetlana Bakalova has been an HR Manager with the company since its foundation. Svetlana holds a Masters Degree in Law from the Burgas Free University and has worked as a lawyer for a number of years.

In 2006 Sunstory acquired land within the plot of Sundance Village Holiday Club in Sunny Beach. In the same year a swimming pool, cafeteria, service and office premises were built by the company and Sunstory took over the maintenance and management of the complex. Long term agreements were signed with the homeowners to include letting out apartments to domestic and international tourists on a hotel basis.

In the meantime the company invested in and began developing its own project in Sunny Beach, called Chateau Del Mar Apartments. This landmark building was completed in 2007 and completely sold-out to foreign investors. Chateau Del Mar was conceived from the ground up with renting out in mind and again long term maintenance and management agreements were signed with all apartment owners. In addition Sunstory owns and operates offices, a lobby bar/cafe/terrace, a reception, and a swimming pool within the complex.
